The aforementioned coaches will be training the players in a round robin format. Unlike most conventional college showcases, the players will work in small-sided groups and will get to interact with both coaches in a rotating session. Essentially, each player will have a chance to be coached and trained by each of the participating college coaches.

By arranging our showcase in this manner, each girl will get to communicate directly with each coach, learn new skills, tactics and showcase their playing ability at the same time. In this environment everyone benefits. Coaches get a chance to meet prospective players and the players gain a sense for the coaches teaching style.
