

NSA U15 Premier Fury in the USYS National League

On December 7, 2008, The NSA U15 Premier Fury completed their first weekend of US Youth Soccer National League play in Raleigh, North Carolina. It was an honor for the team to be selected for this exclusive group of eight elite teams from across the country. Two teams from each of the four regions were chosen to play each other, with the top two teams receiving automatic bids to the US Youth Soccer National Championship in July, 2009. After the first four games, the Fury record stands at one win, three ties and zero losses, putting them temporarily in fourth place.

In the first game the Fury played FC Pennsylvania Strikers, the top ranked team in the country, to a scoreless tie. The second game also was scoreless versus the perennial powerhouse Sand Diego Surf. In the third game, versus defending national champion San Juan Spirits, the Fury went down one goal in the first half, only to tie it up in the second half from a goal by Megan Effner, assisted by Autumn Muckenhirn. The game ended as a tie with one goal apiece. The last game of the weekend was against the Wall Wombats from New Jersey, where Jennifer Korn scored the only goal of the game from a penalty kick. Overall, NSA scored twice and gave up only one goal in the four games played. The team will complete their National League games at the Disney Soccer Showcase in Orlando, Florida from December 31 through January 2.
